This is not only because of the social distancing guidelines, but some courses can also be offered to those in remote communities or those outside of our community. Lesley is pleasantly surprised by how well the online lessons are going and says the children really seem to respond to this type of learning. "Even when social distancing is no longer needed, I think that we will continue to offer some form

of video classes. Kids love it," Lesley smiles, "I spoke to a teacher during a staff meeting who told me that one of the children, during the lesson, accidentally knocked her iPad off the piano, and all the teacher heard was her student saying, "Oh, no! Are you okay?" "It really is a proper lesson." She affirms, "Some students focus better during an online lesson, and practise more as well."

One of the most popular aspects of the NUVO School is community involvement and the opportunity for students to perform in public. NUVO students perform not only at recitals, but also in community venues such as coffee shops or seniors centres. Community is also about the relationship with the student and the family. The structure of the lessons, by welcoming a teacher into a family's home, they establish a personal rapport and this encourages creativity and growth.
